Beginning Violin: (June 4 - June 8)

Explore your hidden potential!

- No prior experience is necessary!
- “Violin campers” should be enrolled in the 3rd through 6th grades.
- Learn scales, folk songs, fiddle tunes, canons, simple ensemble skills, basic music theory and more!
- No need to buy an instrument --- the camp will provide you with the necessary instruments and materials.

Grades 3-9

Intermediate Violin: (June 11 - June 15)

Students have been playing the violin at least one year and mastered good posture and bow holding.

The class will offer varieties of bowing techniques, finger patterns and note reading skills through the String Basics book.

Advanced Violin: (June 18 - June 22)

This class will prepare students for Middle School Intermediate or Advanced Orchestra.

Requirements: Campers must have had 2 or 3 years of violin playing and must be comfortable playing at least Suzuki Book 1 level (for example, are able to play Minuets 1/2/3 by J.S. Bach).

- Learn Orchestra Techniques: various bowing skills, note reading, sight reading, counting, shifting (3rd position study), vibrato and more.
- Learn music theory: key signatures, time signatures, major scale systems, terminology.
- Learn fine ensemble skills: harmony, dynamics, and tone color.
- Learn proper tuning techniques.
- Learn classical genres of music along with contemporary music, folk songs, fiddle tunes.

Robotics Camp: (June 4 - June 8)

This course presents an overview of robotics in practice and research with topics including vision, motion planning, mobile mechanisms, and sensors. In course projects, students construct robots which are driven by a microcontroller. Students work in teams of two: a mechanical engineer, and a computer scientist. This course will also expose students to some of the contemporary happenings in robotics, which includes current robot lab research, applications, robot contests and robots in the news.

Robotic Campers should be enrolled in grades 6-9.

Woodwind Camp: (June 4 - June 8)

This camp is for all 5th -9th grade students who are currently woodwind players – Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, and all Saxophones. This camp will ROCK! It's all about those woodwinds ! You will be learning all of the woodwind techniques – Reeds, better sound, fun music, new notes – plus fun camp activities! This is a five day camp with a parent concert on Friday. You will be playing solos, duets, tros and quartets! If you want to become a better woodwind player – First chair, All County band – how about All state band? Well, you need to be a part of this camp! All students attending this camp must have their own instruments.

Brass: (June 11 - June 15)

Taught by James Samz – one of the best brass teachers in Florida! This camp is for any 5th-9th grade student who currently plays a brass instrument – Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone and Tuba. This is a fun and fast paced camp – focus will be working on all brass techniques – all geared to help you become a much better brass player! Do you want first chair? Do you want to make All County and All State bands? Well, then this is the camp for you! The camp will meet for five days with a parent concert on the last day of camp. Come and work with other brass players ! All camp members must have their own instrument – Tubas and baritones will be provided if needed

Steel Drums: (Beginning, June 4 - June 8 and Advanced, June 11 - June 15)

Hey Mon! Steel Drum camps will fill up fast! There will be two camps offered to entering 6th through 9th grade. Beginning Steel Camp will be for students who have not played Steel before. The week will be filled with steel drum basics, lots of Caribbean music and a concert on Friday to show off our new talents! There is no need to purchase anything – all equipment will be provided. Advanced Steel Drums (2nd week) will be for students who HAVE played Steel Drums before. This is an opportunity to be part of a fast paced, advanced steel drum class. We will be covering a lot of music and different styles of music – Latin, Caribbean, funk, and many more. At the end of the five days we will perform a concert that is sure to get everyone dancing! If you have mallets please bring them.

Summer Drama Camp: (June 4 - June 22)

This Musical Theatre summer camp is designed to uphold the highest level of excellence, education and fun!
