

SAC Meeting Meetings

March 27, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 by Dr. Millins.

The January minutes were reviewed and approved.

Dr. Millins reviewed Dr. Atkins' vision 2020 and our goals the year.

Dr. Millins presented a ppt on school safety and what the district and the school is doing to remain diligent in ensuring all students are safe. Questions were asked regarding doors and cameras and Dr. Millins reviewed what is currently in place and plans for electronic doors/live video camera access for back doors/screens in the MS hallways/and a buzzer system that is being considered. He discussed the new addition of LCSO in all schools.

Parents requested more information about Bullying and what is being done. Dr. Millins reviewed the Jeffrey Johnson Act and the required protocols for investigating bullying. Parents asked about providing more mental health counselors. Dr. Millins discussed possible Title I funding and considering that resource but how that would impact teaching staff. He also explained Baker Acts and the policy regarding students threatening self-harm.

Parents requested the website be up to date that calendar dates online are not correct. Ms. Blackmon communicated with Mr. Klinginsmith via e-mail to correct this.

Ms. Blackmon requested parents consider being SAC chair and DAC representative to continue to have a voice and an audience at the district level each month. Nominations will be taken at the April 17 meeting.

Dr. Millins reviewed data from Q3 and the focus for Q4.
